LONDON TO BRIGHTON IN SUPPORT OF GLASSDOOR

Mike Burton will be cycling the 85km from London to Brighton today in aid of Glassdoor - the homeless charity that has a long link with St Barnabas.

The demands on the charity are acute with lockdown exacerbating an already difficult problem. Last year they still managed to help 1,600 people with over 400 finding work and a permanent place to live and that number is expected to rise this winter. They have noticed a sizeable rise in the number women on the streets as well as a stream of trafficked refugees being forced to pay back crossing fees so your help is needed more than ever.

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ
according to Mark:

All: GLORY TO YOU, O LORD

³⁰They went on from there and passed through Galilee.
He did not want anyone to know it; ³¹for he was
teaching his disciples, saying to them, 'The Son of Man
is to be betrayed into human hands, and they will kill
him, and three days after being killed, he will rise
again.' ³²But they did not understand what he was
saying and were afraid to ask him.

³³Then they came to Capernaum; and when he was in
the house he asked them, 'What were you arguing
about on the way?' ³⁴But they were silent, for on the
way they had argued with one another about who was
the greatest. ³⁵He sat down, called the twelve, and said
to them, 'Whoever wants to be first must be last of all
and servant of all.' ³⁶Then he took a little child and put
