and Leviathan that you formed to sport in it.
${ }^{27}$ These all look to you
to give them their food in due season;
${ }^{28}$ when you give to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are filled with good things.
${ }^{29}$ When you hide your face, they are dismayed; when you take away their breath, they die and return to their dust.
${ }^{30}$ When you send forth your spirit, ${ }^{[g]}$ they are created; and you renew the face of the ground.

${ }^{33}$ I will sing to the Lord as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have being.
${ }^{34}$ May my meditation be pleasing to him, for I rejoice in the Lord.
${ }^{35}$ Bless the Lord, $\mathbf{O}$ my soul.
Praise the Lord!

## BIBLE READING Acts 2.1-13

${ }^{1}$ When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. ${ }^{2}$ And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.
${ }^{3}$ Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue
rested on each of them. ${ }^{4}$ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.
${ }^{5}$ Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. ${ }^{6}$ And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. ${ }^{7}$ Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? ${ }^{8}$ And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? ${ }^{9}$ Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ${ }^{10}$ Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, ${ }^{11}$ Cretans and Arabs-in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power." ${ }^{12}$ All were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" ${ }^{13}$ But others sneered and said, "They are filled with new wine."
